PLEASE READ ALL OF THE ENCLOSED INFORMATION



The total number of parade units is limited, so we may not be able to accept all applications. Parade entries providing the most viewer interest will be given priority. No individual or unit will be allowed to take part in the parade without prior approval of the parade committee.

All individuals and organizations participating in the parade are subject, while in City of Beaver Creek, to the laws and regulations of that jurisdiction. Failure to adhere to those laws and regulations, or to obey the lawful command of an official empowered to give such a command, will be cause for immediate removal from the parade and may cause for arrest and/or fine. Marshals assigned for that purpose will control the conduct and movement of the parade. Participants will obey the direction of the Marshals as they relate to the parade. Failure to do so will cause the offending individual or unit to be removed from the parade.

GENERAL INFORMATION



The parade will move at the rate of 120 adult steps to the minute. Any unit incapable of maintaining that pace for the duration of the parade will not be included.

All units with children under third-grade level are expected to station adults along the parade route to assist tired marchers. Alternative uniforms or costumes should be available in case of excessive heat, cold or rainy weather.

Throwing of any objects from the parade is strictly prohibited. No firecrackers or discharge of firearms are allowed. Violators will be removed from the parade.

Individuals and organizations in the parade are expected to perform courteously, in good taste and with safety in mind at all times during the formation, execution and dismissal of the parade. Marshals will remove any person or unit that violates this regulation.

No alcoholic beverages are permitted on or around any parade units.

WHEN AND WHERE TO BE



The parade will be held on Sunday, July 4, 2010 starting at 6:00 PM. The parade route will begin at the intersection of Meadowbridge Drive and Dayton-Xenia Road. Floats will be lined up North of Dayton Xenia on Meadowbridge near Shoup Park; all other participants will be on Meadowbridge South of Dayton-Xenia Road. Please plan to arrive by 5:00 PM. It is important that the units are parked in their assigned spot!

Enclosed is the Parade Application Form which must be filled out completely and returned by June 18, 2010 to: Beaver Creek Fourth of July Committee, 789 Orchard Lane, Beaver Creek, OH 45434, in order for your unit to be assigned a position in the parade. The public address commentary comes from the information you supply to us on the application. Please provide as much information as you are able; use a second page if necessary. Make sure that your application is legible.
